A total of four plants are being planned for development in the area of Karnataka. Each of the plants will be capable of processing over a thousand metric tons of garbage in a day. The primary aim of the project is to eliminate toxic landfills and control air pollution in the city.

When asked about the value of the project, president of LaSalle International Pierre Lasalle had this to say, “Energy conversation is a challenge in underdeveloped nations. Bangalore is one of the most polluted cities in India. The power plants will be designed to emit very low emissions in order to curb air pollution.
